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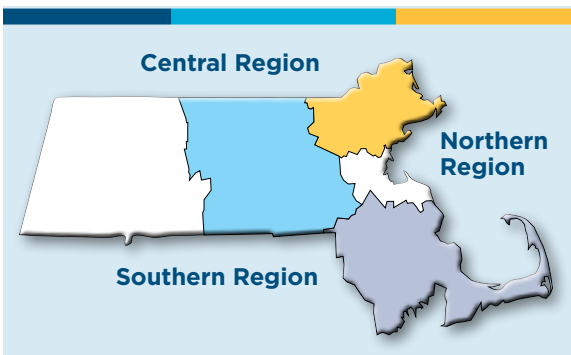


What is a Long Term Services and Supports (LTSS) Community Partner?

LTSS Community Partners (CPs) are community-based health care and human services organizations experienced in providing long-term services and supports.

CPs work with Accountable Care Organizations (ACOs) and Managed Care Organizations (MCOs) to provide care coordination and supports to enhance health outcomes, independence, and quality of life for the citizens of Massachusetts, and better value to MassHealth.

Massachusetts Care Coordination Network (MCCN) is an LTSS CP covering the Northern, Central, and Southern regions of Massachusetts.



How Does MCCN Coordinate Care?

MCCN care coordination involves a broad range of support functions that assist individuals to better navigate their long-term services and supports, and to improve coordination of their care. MCCN's experienced care coordinators work closely with each individual to provide the following services:

- Outreach & Engagement
- LTSS Care Coordination & Planning, including Choice Counseling
- Care Team Participation
- Support for Transitions of Care
- Health & Wellness Coaching
- Connection to Social Services & Community Resources, including Flexible Services
